Nature and Scope:

Reporting to the Maintenance Coordinator, the Facility Maintenance Worker provides support for the repair, cleaning and improvements of the Camp Thunderbird Outdoor Centre during the Summer Camp and Outdoor Education seasons. This is a hands-on position that will help the department to provide excellent customer service to all clients and families and ongoing support for staff.

The successful candidate for this position must be available to work a variety of shifts, and available on short notice for coverage, including weekends and evenings. This is classified as a seasonal position working up to 35 hours per week for the summer season (April to September); there is the possibility of limited hours in the off-season.

This casual position is entitled to an individual YMCA-YWCA membership.

Responsibilities:

- Support the site Maintenance Coordinator with a wide variety of improvement projects including, but not limited to: cleaning, painting, minor plumbing, carpentry and electrical repairs/installations, etc.
- Janitorial duties of shared and public facilities such as washrooms and showers.
- Ensure that the buildings, facilities, property and equipment are clean, safe and in good repair.
- Maintain hiking trails and outdoor program areas.
- Follow all Health and Safety policies and procedures.
- Adhere to and role model the YMCA-YWCA core values in all program activities Caring, Respect, Responsibility and Honesty
- Maintain a safe working environment and ensure others do the same.
- Perform duties in a manner that respects the educational and environmental goals of Camp
- Support Camp Counsellors/Instructors with projects relating to program delivery.
- Performs other related duties as assigned by supervisor

- Education High School graduation is preferred
